GEOGRAPHY




Topics - The Human habitat, population & settlement patterns, the natural world - volcanoes, glaciers, earthquakes & storms and climate change






HOME ECONOMICS



Food health and culinary skills 46.4%	Students are enabled to develop a healthy, sustainable attitude and positive relationship with food through practical experiential learning.






